Now we’ve reached 1630 items on our library shelves. All current members are invited to come in and borrow a book, DVD, or video. The library is available to current members whenever they’d wish. Just ask me (Barb) or a board member how to get access.

TO SEARCH for a book:

1. Turn on the “Librarian” computer
2. Log on as “EAA Chapter 113”. No password required.
3. Click on the “Resource Mate-Patron Search” icon. (That is our online catalog. It replaces the old fashioned card catalog and its many drawers!)
4. You are asked 3 things:
  - a. what TYPE MATERIAL do you want? (“book”, “any”, Just click on the pop-up menu)
  - b. What TEXT to search for? (type in the box)
  - c. What do you want to search in ? TITLES, AUTHORS, SUBJECTS, or KEYWORD?

Click on one of these boxes to choose.

(Caution: keyword searches may take a bit longer – more stuff to search through.)

Now the top of the page is a list of books & items, while the bottom shows you details of whatever is highlighted at the top. There is a blue line between top/bottom where it tells you how many search results it has found for you. You can scroll through these using the scroll bar on the right, highlighting whichever you like for more info.

In the DETAILS section, you can change your view by selecting 1 of 4 tabs: DETAILS, LIBRARY CARD, LIBN COMMENTS, NOTES. I suggest the LIB CARD view.\* It also gives info as to what subject headings have been assigned, and the shelf number is over on the left side. Grab a piece of paper, jot down your info, and go search on the shelf.

Let me know if you have trouble.
